**Wonderings / possible sections for poster**

- What fish are in the lake?
- Are there any legends concerning the land form?
- What is the landform's history?
- How was it formed?
- What is the future of this landform? E.g. 100 years from now.
- What plant life can the landform support?
- What animals can / does this landform support?
- Who discovered this landform?
- Where did the name come from?
- What other landforms are part of the landform (volcano / island)
- Are there conflicts between people and nature (beavers)
- What are the measurements of the landform? Height, length, depth, temp.
- Is the landform hospitable for people?
