 - Embedded in everything- all day long!

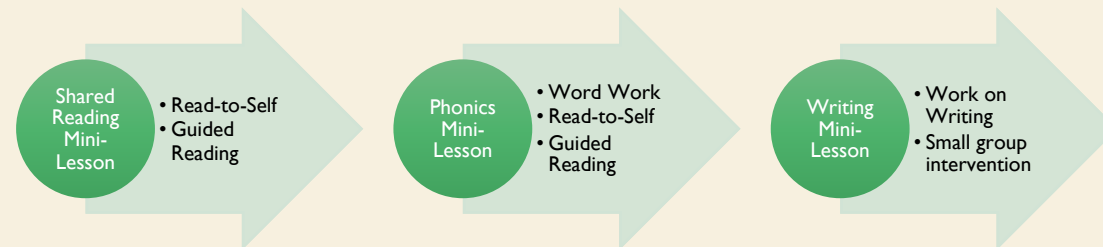
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READER'S WORKSHOP
